ALPINE PLATEAU, GUNNISON N.F. - 175 ACRES. FIRE IS LOCATED NEXT TO THE BIG BLUE WILDERNESS. ATTEMPTING TO CONTAIN THE FIRE OUTSIDE OF THE WILDERNESS. NO ESTIMATE OF CONTAINMENT.
