SHIRTTAIL, BLACK HILLS N.F. - 3,000 ACRES. TYPE II TEAM (ANDERSON) COMMITTED. FIRE IS LOCATED 10 MILES NORTH OF HOT SPRINGS. FIRE HAS BURNED INTO WIND CAVE NATIONAL PARK, CREWS HAVE BURNED OUT AROUND THE PARK HEADQUARTERS FOR STRUCTURE PROTECTION. NO ESTIMATE OF CONTAINMENT.

ANALYSIS: LIGHTNING ACTIVITY COUPLED WITH HIGH WINDS AND UNSEASONABLY WARM TEMPERATURES BROUGHT SIGNIFICANT FIRE ACTIVITY TO THE BLACK HILLS NATIONAL FOREST. ONE TYPE I CREW AND 13 TYPE II CREWS, 6 AIRTANKERS, ONE RADIO SYSTEM, 2 CATERERS AND 2 SHOWER UNITS HAVE BEEN COMMITTED THROUGH THE NATIONAL INTERAGENCY COORDINATION CENTER TO THE FIRES ON THE BLACK HILLS NATIONAL FOREST. ONE CATERER IS COMMITTED TO THE FIRE IN MONTANA.

PROGNOSIS: EXPECT FIRE ACTIVITY TO CONTINUE IN THE BLACK HILLS WITH THE WEATHER FORECAST PREDICTING HIGH TEMPERATURES AND POSSIBLE THUNDERSTORMS. RESOURCES REMAIN ADEQUATE.
