FIRE WEATHER: ALASKA - MOSTLY SUNNY EXCEPT PARTLY CLOUDY COAST AND NORTH SLOPE. ISOLATED AFTERNOON SHOWERS MAINLY MOUNTAINS NORTH AND ALONG THE COAST. HIGHS UPPER 70'S AND 80'S. MINIMUM RELATIVE HUMIDITY 15-25 PERCENT.

COLORADO - PARTLY CLOUDY WITH AFTERNOON AND EVENING THUNDERSTORMS SCATTERED EAST AND ISOLATED WEST. HIGHS 70'S TO LOWER 80'S MOUNTAINS AND UPPER 70'S TO MID 90'S LOWER ELEVATIONS. MINIMUM RELATIVE HUMIDITY 20-30 PERCENT. WINDS WEST TO NORTHWEST 15-30 MPH.

ARIZONA - MOSTLY SUNNY AND WARMER. HIGHS MID 70'S TO LOW 80'S MOUNTAINS AND 102-107 LOWER DESERTS. MINIMUM RELATIVE HUMIDITY 5-15 PERCENT DESERTS AND 15-25 PERCENT MOUNTAINS. LIGHT WINDS.

NEW MEXICO - PARTLY CLOUDY WITH CHANCE OF AFTERNOON & EVENING THUNDERSTORMS MOSTLY EAST OF THE CENTRAL MOUNTAIN CHAIN. HIGHS 70\* S TO 80'S MOUNTAINS.. AND 80'S TO 90\* S LOWER ELEVATIONS. MINIMUM RELATIVE HUMIDITY 20-30 PERCENT. SOUTHEAST TO SOUTHWEST WINDS 10-20 MPH EXCEPT GUSTS TO 25 MPH NORTHEAST PLAINS.

ANALYSIS: EXTREME INDICES IN ALASKA AND THE SOUTHWEST AS WELL AS INDICES RISING TO EXTREME IN COLORADO. ONE AIRTANKER MOBILIZED FROM THE LOWER 48 TO ALASKA.

PROGNOSIS: EXPECT ACTIVITY TO CONTINUE AND INCREASE IN ALASKA, THE SOUTHWEST AND COLORADO. RESOURCES REMAIN ADEQUATE WITH NO SHORTAGES ANTICIPATED.
