NEW MEXICO - WINDY STATEWIDE, SOUTH TO SOUTHWEST WINDS 25-35 MPH. PARTLY CLOUDY NORTHWEST WITH A FEW AFTERNOON SHOWERS. MOSTLY FAIR SOUTH AND EAST. HIGHS MOSTLY 70'S MOUNTAINS AND NORTHWEST TO THE 90'S SOUTHEAST PLAINS.

KENAI PENINSULA - MOSTLY CLOUDY WITH A FEW SHOWERS. NORTHWEST WINDS 10-15 MPH. HIGHS IN THE LOWER 50'S. MINIMUM RELATIVE HUMIDITY NEAR 70 PERCENT.

ANALYSIS: INITIAL ATTACK ACTIVITY CONTINUING IN THE SOUTHWEST WITH SEVERAL AREAS REPORTING VERY HIGH AND EXTREME FIRE INDICES.

PROGNOSIS: CONTINUED ACTIVITY EXPECTED IN THE SOUTHWEST. NO RESOURCE SHORTAGES ANTICIPATED.
