EASTERN U.S. - MUCH OF THE AREA WILL BE FAIR THIS WEEKEND. HOWEVER SNOW IS FORECAST FOR PORTIONS OF THE LAKE STATES, NORTHEAST AND THE APPALACHIANS. HIGHS WILL BE IN THE 50'S AND 60'S WITH 70'S ALONG THE GULF COAST. THE LAKE STATES AND NORTHEAST WILL REMAIN COLD WITH HIGHS ONLY INTO THE 20'S AND 30'S.

WESTERN U.S. - A PACIFIC STORM WILL BRING RAIN TO THE PACIFIC NORTHWEST AND NORTHERN CALIFORNIA COAST SATURDAY. SHOWERS MOVING INTO THE GREAT BASIN AND NORTHERN ROCKIES LATE SATURDAY AND SUNDAY. FAIR ELSEWHERE. HIGHS WILL BE IN THE 50' S AND 60»S EXCEPT 70' S AND 80'S IN THE DESERTS

ANALYSIS: MINOR ACTIVITY OCCURRING IN THE NORTHERN ROCKIES, SOUTHWEST, EASTERN AND SOUTHERN AREAS.

FIRE WEATHER

EASTERN U.S. - STORM SYSTEM SPREADING SHOWERS AND THUNDERSHOWERS FROM TEXAS THROUGH THE MISSISSIPPI VALLEY. SNOW OVER THE OHIO RIVER VALLEY AREA. SNOW SPREADING INTO THE MID-ATLANTIC STATES SUNDAY. PARTLY CLOUDY ELSEWHERE. WARM IN THE SOUTHEAST WITH 60'S AND 70'S. COLD IN THE LAKE STATES AND NORTHEAST WITH HIGHS IN THE 20'S AND 30'S.

WESTERN U.S. - PACIFIC STORM SYSTEM MOVING INLAND THIS WEEKEND WITH SHOWERS AND MOUNTAIN SNOW FROM CALIFORNIA TO THE ROCKIES. FAIR AND MILD PACIFIC NORTHWEST AND NORTHERN INTERMOUNTAIN AREA. HIGHS 50'S AND 60'S EXCEPT 70'S SOUTHWEST DESERTS.

ANALYSIS: INCREASED FIRE ACTIVITY IS OCCURRING IN THE SOUTHWEST AND SOUTHERN AREAS.

PROGNOSIS: NO RESOURCE SHORTAGES EXPECTED.
