Current Situation: Southern California and the Southwest were the only areas reporting significant fire activity. Demobilization is in progress from several large fires in the Southwest. Large **fire** activity continued in Canada with 318,682 additional acres burned.

New Mexico will be hot and dry with isolated thundershowers over the north central mountains. Highs will range in the 70's and 80's in the north, to near 100 in the south. Southern California will be sunny and warmer. Highs will be in the 70's in the mountains, 70's and 80's along the coast, 90's in the valleys and upper 90's to 112 in the eastern deserts. The Great Lakes states will be mostly cloudy and humid with showers and thundershowers over most areas. Highs will range from the 70's to low 90's. The potential for increased initial attack and large fire activity remains as the holiday week continues.
