Outlook: Arizona will be dry, locally breezy and hotter. Highs will range from the low 80's in the mountains to 117 degrees in the southern deserts. New Mexico will be hot and dry with highs in the mid 70's in the north to near 102 degrees in the south. Southern California will be sunny with a chance of thundershowers over the mountains. Highs will be in the 70's in the mountains, 70's and 80's along the coast, 90's in the valleys and upper 90's to 115 degrees in the eastern deserts. The Great Lakes states will be mostly cloudy and humid with showers and thundershowers, except Minnesota which will have decreasing clouds. Highs will be in the 70's to near 80. The potential for increased initial attack and large fire activity continues with hot and dry forecasts.
