OUTLOOK: The upper level low pressure system over Montana will move into the Dakotas today. Strong high pressure will build from the Pacific Coast into the Today will be sunny and warm from Oregon, Washington and Great Basin. California into Nevada, Idaho and western Montana. High temperatures will range from the 70's and 80's in the Northwest, to the 90's in central and southern California. It will be partly cloudy with a few showers and thundershowers from southeast Montana through eastern Wyoming and northern Utah. Monsoon moisture will continue to flow into the desert Southwest. Colorado, New Mexico and eastern Arizona can expect numerous thundershowers, with temperatures from the 90's in western Colorado to 110 degrees for the desert southwest. High pressure will bring sunny skies and mild temperatures to most of the Northeast, with the exception of northern Maine where increasing clouds are forecast. High temperatures will range from the mid 60's in the north to the mid 70's in the southern portion of the region. Fire activity is expected to remain moderate across the U.S.
