Current Situation: Minor fire activity continued across most of the U.S.

Eastern Great Basin Large Fires:

WHISKEY, Boise N.F. A Type II Incident Management Team (Burdick) has been ordered. The fire is burning in a Sub-Alpine fir fuel type, with frequent spotting. Fire activity remained active into the evening.

SHADROCK MOUNTAIN, Massachusetts. The fire is burning in Russell and Montgomery Counties. The C-130 in Manchester dropped 3 loads of retardant on the fire yesterday. Two dairy farms and one residence are currently threatened.

OUTLOOK: Strong high pressure will continue to bring sunny and unseasonably warmer weather to the West today. Thunderstorm activity will be minimal with only isolated thunderstorms forecast for the mountains of New Mexico. High temperatures will range from the 70's and 80's in the northern portion of the West to the 80's and 90's in the south, and 100-112 in the desert Southwest. A moist southwest flow will bring cloudy skies, showers and a few thundershowers to the northeastern U.S. Humidities will be higher and winds will be gusting from the southwest. High temperatures will range from the mid 60's in the northern portion to mid 80's in the southern portion. Fire activity is expected to remain moderate.
