

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 MONDAY, OCTOBER 9, 1995 - 0900 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

Current Situation: Initial attack activity continued in California, while the remainder of the country experienced minimal activity.

Hurricane Opal Support:

A Type I Incident Management Team (O'Bannon) was released yesterday from Montgomery, Alabama.

A Type II Incident Management Team (Kearney) is operating a receiving and distribution center in Florida to support FEMA recovery efforts.

OUTLOOK: A moderate westerly flow over the Pacific Northwest will push a series of weak upper level disturbances across the area. This will bring showers to Washington, northern Idaho and the Oregon coast. A weak flow over the Southwest will continue dry weather for that region. High temperatures will range from the 40's and 50's over the Northern Rockies, 60's to mid 70's along the Pacific coast and Great Basin and mid 80's to mid 90's from the central California valleys to the desert Southwest. Minor initial attack activity is expected in the western U.S.
