## INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT TUESDAY, OCTOBER 10, 1995 - 0530 MDT NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

Current Situation: Initial attack activity continued in California, while the remainder of the country experienced minimal activity.

#### Hurricane Opal Support:

A Type II Incident Management Team (Kearney) is operating a receiving and distribution center in Florida to support FEMA recovery efforts.

OUTLOOK: A moderate westerly flow over the Pacific Northwest will push a series of weak upper level disturbances across the area. This will bring rain showers from the Oregon coast through western Monatana. Winds will be gusting from 25-50 MPH in Montana east of the Continental Divide. High pressure over the Southwest will bring dry and warmer weather to the remainder of the West. High temperatures will range from the upper 50's to upper 70's along the Pacific coast and northern Great Basin. Low 80's to low 90's will occur from the southern Great Basin to the central California valleys. Temperatures from southern California to the desert Southwest will be from 95 to 100 degrees. Minor initial attack activity is expected to continue.
