### INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 11, 1995 - 0530 MDT NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

Current Situation: No significant fire activity is occurring nationally. The Southern Area continues to demobilize resources. The Incident Management Teams committed to the floods in Alaska have been released.

Hurricane Opal Support:

A Type II Incident Management Team (Kearney) is operating a receiving and distribution center in Florida to support FEMA recovery efforts.

OUTLOOK: \*\*\* A FIRE WEATHER WATCH IS POSTED FOR THE UPPER SACRAMENTO VALLEY FOR STRONG GUSTY NORTH WINDS, LOW HUMIDITIES AND WARM TEMPERATURES. \*\*\*

A vigorous upper level trough moving onto the Washington and Oregon coasts will bring cooler temperatures and rain showers to the Northwest, with snow showers in the higher mountain elevations. Northern Idaho and western Montana will have more rain showers today. High pressure over New Mexico will bring dry and very warm weather to the Southwest. Northern California will have gusty north to west winds 20-35 MPH. High temperatures will be in the mid 50's to upper 70's along the Pacific coast and the upper Great Basin. Low 80's to low 90's will occur from the lower Great Basin to the central California valleys. Temperatures from southern California to the desert Southwest will be from 95 to 102 degrees. The potential for increased fire activity is possible with the fire weather watch in effect in California.
