### INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT THURSDAY, OCTOBER 12, 1995 - 0530 MDT NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

Current Situation: Minimal fire activity continued throughout the U.S.

Hurricane Opal Support:

The Type II Incident Management Team (Kearney) was released yesterday from their assignment in Florida.

OUTLOOK: \*\*\* A FIRE WEATHER WATCH IS POSTED FOR THE SACRAMENTO VALLEY AND THE SURROUNDING FOOTHILLS FOR GUSTY NORTH TO NORTHEAST WINDS AND LOW HUMIDITIES.\*\*\*

A vigorous upper level trough over western Montana and Wyoming will move east across both states today. This system will bring scattered rain and snow showers and local gusty west to northwest winds of 20-40 MPH to the area. Temperatures will be much cooler over the Northern Rockies with highs in the 40's and 50's. A dry high pressure system building over the Northwest will produce north to northwest winds at 20-35 MPH over northern California. Highs will range from the upper 50's to the upper 70's along the Pacific coast and over the central Great Basin. Highs will be in the 80's and 90's from the lower Great Basin to the southern California valleys. The Southwest will have dry and warm weather, with temperatures in the deserts reaching 95-103 degrees. The potential for increased fire activity exists for California with the Fire Weather Watch.
