# INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT FRIDAY, OCTOBER 13, 1995 - 0530 MDT NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

Current Situation: Fire activity remained minimal across the U.S.

OUTLOOK: \*\*\* A RED FLAG WARNING IS POSTED FOR THE SACRAMENTO VALLEY AND THE WEST SLOPES OF THE SIERRAS FOR GUSTY NORTH TO EAST WINDS AT 20-35 MPH AND LOW HUMIDITIES. \*\*\*

\*\*\* A FIRE WEATHER WATCH IS POSTED FOR THE EXTREME NORTHWEST CORNER OF ARIZONA FOR GUSTY NORTH WINDS AND LOW HUMIDITIES. \*\*\*

Strong high pressure, both at the surface and aloft, will build over the West Coast and Great Basin states. An upper trough will move out of the Rockies and into the Great Plains. California, southern Nevada and Arizona will be very warm and dry with local gusty winds. Most of the West will have sunny skies except the Northwest and Northern Rockies which will be partly cloudy. A cold front will sag into northern and eastern New Mexico, bringing a few showers to the mountains of northern New Mexico. High temperatures will range from the 50's and 60's in the northern and central Rockies to the 80's and 90's in Southern California and the Southwest. The potential for increased fire activity in California continues with the Red Flag Warning.
