A deepening upper level trough will move from the Pacific Northwest into the Northern Rockies and Great Basin. This system will bring much cooler temperatures and windy conditions as far south as southern California and northern Arizona. Local north to west winds gusting to 40 mph will occur in southern California. Scattered valley rain showers and mountain snow showers should occur in Washington, Oregon, Idaho, Montana, western Wyoming, and northern Utah. Dry weather should prevail elsewhere. High temperatures will be in the 30's to mid 40's in the Northern Rockies. Temperatures from the 50's to the lower 70's should occur along the Pacific Coast, with mid 40's to 60's in the Great Basin. The central California valleys and the desert Southwest will have highs in the 80's to the upper 90's. Increased fire activity may occur in California and the desert Southwest. Other Areas should experience decreased activity.
