## INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT THURSDAY NOVEMBER 9, 1995 - 1000 MST NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

Current Situation: Fire activity in California and the Great Basin resulted from prescribed fires receiving unexpected gusty winds.

OUTLOOK: A cold front will move into northern California with clouds and a few showers from Redding northward. Central California will be partly cloudy while southern California remains mostly sunny. It will be cooler and breezy statewide. High temperatures will range from the 50's and 60's in the north and mountains to near 80 in the southern deserts. Winds will be south to west at 15-35 MPH in the mountains and higher elevations deserts. Minor fire activity is possible in southern California until significant precipitation occurs.
