INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT

FRIDAY FEBRUARY 9, 1996 - 1000 MST NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION: Initial attack fire activity moderated in the Southern Area due to cool, wet weather this past week. Initial attack activity occurred in the Southwest and Eastern Area. Numerous counties in Oregon, Washington and northern Idaho have been declared disaster areas due to flooding. Urban areas along the Willamette River, including Salem, Eugene and the Portland metropolitan area were evacuated yesterday. Residences along the Washington side of the Columbia River in the Vancouver area were also evacuated. Numerous roads and highways in Washington and Oregon are closed. Local Forest and District teams are assessing damage.

OUTLOOK: An upper level low pressure system off the central California coast will drift slowly southeast. A weak upper level ridge will remain over Arizona and New Mexico through the weekend. The upper level low will push the ridge away Monday and Tuesday. Dry weather is expected for the weekend with a slight chance of showers and thunderstorms over southern Arizona and New Mexico later in the week. Temperatures will be in the 50's in the mountains to 80's in the deserts. Rain over the Northwest will decrease Friday to isolated showers.

Cooler temperatures are expected for the coming week, reducing the snow melt and relieving flooding. Minor initial attack activity is expected to continue in the Southern, Eastern and Southwest Areas.
