NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION: Minor initial attack activity continued in the Southwest Area. No new large fire activity occurred nationally.

OUTLOOK: An upper level ridge will intensify over Southern California, Arizona and New Mexico bringing sunshine, dry conditions and higher temperatures. Mountainous areas will have high temperatures in the 70's and 80's, with desert temperatures ranging from the 90's to 107 degrees. Florida will be partly cloudy with temperatures in the 80's, easterly winds 10-20 MPH, and a chance of afternoon showers and thunderstorms. Initial attack activity is expected to increase in the Southwest Area as hot and dry conditions return.
