CURRENT SITUATION: Fire activity continued in the Northern Rockies and Great Basin Areas. Resource mobilization through NICC remained minimal with three Type II helicopters mobilized, two to the Clear Creek fire in Nevada and one to the Campgroud fire in Utah.

Northern Rockies Large Fires:

ROGERS MOUNTAIN, Northwest Montana State. A Type II Incident Management Team (Gauger) is assigned. High value timber and plantations, decked and unguarded logs, uncut stands and regenerated units are currently threatened. Calmer winds yesterday resulted in slow to moderate rates of spread. Steep slopes, red slash and a streamside protection management zone are current concerns and hazards.

Northwest Large Fires:

MYRTLE, Wenatchee NF. A Type II Incident Management Team (Furlong) is assigned. Steep slopes and heavy timber are causing control problems on this fire burning about 30 miles northwest of Chelan, WA. Threats remain to the wilderness.

BELL-A-BONANZA, Burns District, BLM. This fire is burning in heavy grass 25 miles southeast of Burns, OR. Low humidities, winds and limited access are hampering control efforts. The town of Crane, wheat fields and winter range are threatened.

The current threat is to a cabin at a mine, fisheries and critical Mule Deer and Sage Grouse habitat.

OUTLOOK:

An upper level low will track eastward along the Arizona and Utah border bringing showers and thunderstorms to eastern Utah, southern Wyoming, Colorado and southward along the Arizona and New Mexico border. A weak upper level disturbance will bring widely scattered showers in Washington and northern Idaho. An upper level ridge will bring warm and dry weather to the remainder of the West. High temperatures will range from the 50's in the areas receiving precipitation in the central Rockies, 60's and 70's in the northern Rockies, 70's and 80's in the Great Basin and 90's to near 100 in the desert Southwest.
