CURRENT SITUATION: Fire activity continued in the Eastern Great Basin, and increased in Southern California. Resource mobilization through NICC remained moderate.

Eastern Great Basin Large Fires:

FAYETTE, Bridger-Teton NF. A Type II Incident Management Team (Summerfelt) is assigned. This fire is burning on both Wyoming State and Forest Service lands 5 miles east of Pinedale, WY. A resort, ranch and campgrounds are threatned.

SPILLWAY, Wasatch-Cache NF. This fire is located 10 miles east of Ogden, UT above the Pineview Dam.

A strong upper level ridge from Arizona through the Great Basin will bring unseasonably warm and dry weather with near record high temperatures to much of the West. High temperatures will range from the 70's and 80's in the Rockies, 80's and 90's in the Great Basin and upper 90's in the northern California valleys. The southwest deserts will have temperatures reaching 111.
