CURRENT SITUATION: Fire activity was minimal throughout most of the western United States. Good progress was made on large fires.

Southern California Large Fires:

WILD, Los Padres NF. A Type I Incident Management Team (Dague) is assigned. This fire is burning 25 miles south of Big Sur, CA. High humidities made burnout operations difficult yesterday. Structure protection remains in place for a historical cabin and several private homes.

Northern Rockies Large Fires:

Thirty-four fires are in a confine and contain suppression strategy totaling 54,800 acres.

OUTLOOK:

An upper level trough, moving onto the west coast, will bring a cooling trend to most of the western U.S. A surface cold front ahead of this trough will extend from Montana through northern Nevada. The front will produce scattered rain and snow showers in Montana and a few showers in Idaho, northwest Wyoming, northern Oregon and Washington. High pressure aloft remains over the southern Rockies but continues to weaken. Unstable air in southeast Arizona and southwest New Mexico may produce isolated dry thunderstorms. High temperatures will range from the 50's and 60's in the pacific northwest to the upper 90's in the southwest deserts. The central Rockies to California will have temperatures in the 70's to lower 80's.
