

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT

 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

*** ALL FIREFIGHTERS HAVE THE RIGHT TO A SAFE ASSIGNMENT ***

CURRENT SITUATION: No new significant fire activity was reported in Southern California. The large fires in the Malibu and San Diego areas are nearing containment due to favorable weather conditions. The Sur Fire continues to threaten the community and recreational facilities in Big Sur. Resource mobilization through NICC remained minimal.

Southern California Large Fires:

SUR, Los Padres NF. A Type I Incident Management Team (Giachino) is assigned. Pfeiffer-Big Sur State Park and lodge were evacuated Thursday afternoon. Residents have been alerted for possible evacuations in the event of wind shifts. Structure protection remains in place within the community of Big Sur. Steep terrain with limited access are control problems. Some trails in the Ventana Wilderness have been closed and portions of Highway 1 may be closed due to poor visibility. Light to moderate rainfall was reported on lower portions of the fire last night.

CALABASAS, Los Angeles County, California. This fire is burning in grass and brush south of Highway 101 in the Calabasas and Malibu area. Line construction is nearing completion around the perimeter and unburned islands. Heavy demobilization of local government resources occurred yesterday.

Otay #322, San Diego Ranger Unit, California State. This fire is burning on California Desert District, BLM, and state and private lands. The fire is contained on the west end at the San Diego city limits. Portions of the fire burning into Mexico required no suppression action.
