OUTLOOK: A cold front will approach the Southeast Coast States with breezy southwest winds ahead of it Saturday. This will bring a chance of showers and thunderstorms with breezy northeast winds behind the front. The front will stall across south Florida on Sunday. High pressure will build over the area from Sunday through Tuesday, bringing dry and cooler conditions, except across central and south Florida where a chance of showers will continue. A storm system could form off of the southeast coast late Tuesday and Wednesday, returning the chance of showers to the coastal sections.
