## INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT SUNDAY, MAY 18, 1997 - 0900 MDT NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION: Large fire activity continued in the Great Basin. One Type II helicopter was mobilized to Southern California through NICC.

## EASTERN GREAT BASIN AREA LARGE FIRES:

COGSWELL POINT, Southwest Utah State. A Type II Incident Management Team (Hefner) is assigned. Steep rugged terrain, difficult and limited access are creating safety concerns. Smoke is affecting Zion National Park in the morning hours. Fire behavior not normally experienced for this time of year is occurring. Slightly cooler temperatures and higher relative humidities will improve containment efforts.
