NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION: No significant fire activity was reported. Favorable weather allowed firefighters to achieve containment on the Maybert fire yesterday. Demobilization has begun. Numerous units in the Southwest and Southern California Areas are reporting high to extreme fire indices.

California, southern Great Basin and the Southwest can expect 15-30 mph winds with gusts to 40 mph in southern Nevada and northern Arizona. From the Sierras across central Nevada, Utah, southern Colorado, and northern and eastern New Mexico there will be scattered showers and thundershowers. The southern California coast will have low clouds, fog and drizzle. Temperatures will range from the 60's and 70's in the mountains to the 80's and 90's in the deserts. Minnesota will be cloudy with a chance of showers and thundershowers. Temperatures will range from 65 to 75 degrees.
