INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT WEDNESDAY JUNE 25, 1997 - 0530 MDT NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION: No large fire activity was reported nationally. Alaska reported increased initial attack activity due to dry lightning. Minimal fire activity was reported elsewhere. Fire dangers remain high to extreme in southern California, Nevada, Arizona, New Mexico, Utah and Colorado.

OUTLOOK: Arizona will be mostly sunny with possible wind gusts up to 25 MPH over higher terrain. Temperatures will range from the 80's in the mountains to 105 in the lower deserts. New Mexico will have partly cloudy skies and a few afternoon thunderstorms over the central mountains and the eastern portion of the state. Mountain temperatures will be in the 70's and 80's, with valley and desert highs reaching 100 to 105. California will be mostly sunny, except morning fog and low clouds along the coast. High temperatures will be in the 70's along the coast, 80's and 90's in the inland valleys and 100 to 105 in deserts. Alaska will be mostly cloudy with scattered showers or thunderstorms. Temperatures throughout the state will be in the 70's and 80's.
