INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT FRIDAY JUNE 27, 1997 - 0530 MDT NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION: Fire activity continues to increase in Alaska. Two limited fires burned together gaining 45,000 acres. Very high and extreme fire indices were reported in California, Arizona, New Mexico, Nevada, Utah, Colorado and Montana.

OUTLOOK: Alaska will be mostly sunny with isolated showers or thunderstorms. High temperatures will be in the 60's along the coast and 70's to mid 80's in the interior. California will be sunny, dry and locally breezy. Coastal areas will have patchy morning fog and low clouds. Temperatures will be in the 70's along the coast, 80's to 90's in the inland valleys, and 100-105 degrees in the deserts. Arizona will be mostly sunny and locally breezy. Eastern Arizona will be warm and dry with isolated afternoon thunderstorms. Temperatures will be in the upper 80's in the mountains to 110 in the southern deserts. New Mexico will be partly cloudy with scattered thunderstorms over the mountains. Temperatures will be 70 degrees in the mountains, 90's in the valleys and near 100 in the deserts.
