CURRENT SITUATION: Large fire activity increased in the Eastern Great Basin Area necessitating the mobilization of a Type I Incident Management Team. Fire activity continues to moderate in Alaska. Firefighters have made good progress toward containment objectives. Very high to extreme fire indices persist on numerous units in the Great Basin, Rocky Mountain, Southwest and California Areas.

EASTERN BASIN LARGE FIRES:

FLAT, Richfield District, BLM. A Type I Incident Management Team (Birch) has been ordered. This fire is 10-15 miles south of Richfield, UT. No other information was available.

INOWAK, Southwest Area Forestry, Alaska State. A Type II Incident Management Team (Kechter) is assigned. Significant fire behavior was observed along the east and south perimeters. Crews made good progress on line improvements along Stony River. The village of Red Devil remains threatened.

CAMP LAKE, Tok Area Forestry, Alaska State. This fire is between Tok and Northway. Demobilization was completed yesterday. The fire received rain and will now be monitored. This is the last report unless significant activity occurs.

OUTLOOK:

Alaska will be mostly cloudy with showers in the south, and mostly sunny in the north. A slight chance of afternoon thunderstorms exists for the western interior. Temperatures will range from the 60's along the coast to the mid 70's in the interior.

Increasing high clouds are forecast for California, with fog and low clouds along the coast. The northern Sierra Nevada mountains have a slight chance of afternoon thunderstorms. High temperatures will be in the 60's and 70's along the coast, the 70's and 80's in the mountains, and the 90's in the valleys and deserts.

Arizona and New Mexico will be partly sunny and hot. Scattered dry thunderstorms are possible over central and southern Arizona, with a slight chance of afternoon thunderstorms in New Mexico. Mountain temperatures will be in the 80's and 90's, with desert highs reaching 118.

Partly sunny skies are forecast for Colorado, with isolated afternoon dry thunderstorms in the mountains. Temperatures will range from the 70's in the mountains to 105 in the plains.

Nevada will be sunny and warm. A slight chance of afternoon thunderstorms are possible over the northern mountains. Temperatures will be in the 80's and 90's throughout the state.
