INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT FRIDAY, DECEMBER 12, 1997 - 1000 MST NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION: Minimal fire activity was reported.

OUTLOOK: A stationary front over central Florida will bring rain and a chance of thunderstorms through Sunday. Expect dry conditions Monday through midweek. Highs will be in the 50's and 60's in the north. Highs in the south will range from the 70's to mid 80's, cooling to the upper 60's and 70's Monday and Tuesday. Strong high pressure over the Great Basin will bring warm temperatures and Santa Ana winds to southern California today. Northeast winds over 50 MPH are possible in the canyons and passes. Winds will diminish on Saturday. A pacific trough will bring cooler temperatures, with a chance of valley rain and mountain snow late Sunday and Monday. Dry conditions can be expected by midweek. High temperatures will range from the mid 30's to 40's in the mountains, and upper 60's to mid 70's in the coastal valleys. The coastal valleys will cool to the upper 50's and 60's by Monday.
