## CURRENT SITUATION:

Minimal initial attack activity was reported yesterday. Very high and extreme fire indices were reported in Minnesota, Wisconsin, Texas, New Mexico and Arizona. Three uncontrolled fires are being reported in Alberta for 475, 139 acres. Canada has tasked their military to assist with the Virginia Hills fire. Fifty soldiers and 30 six-wheel-drive trucks will help transport the firefighters.

## SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

CAMP WOOD HILL, Texas State. This fire is burning in grass and cedar 80 miles west of San Antonio, near the community of Camp Wood. One barn has been destroyed and numerous homes are threatened.

BOOGY JORDAN, Florida National Forests. The fire is burning mostly on private land near the Apalachicola National Forest.

OUTLOOK:

A FIRE WEATHER WATCH IS POSTED FOR LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITY IN FLORIDA. Florida will be mostly sunny and dry with minimum relative humilities as low as 25 percent. High temperatures will be in the $80^{\prime}$ s.

A FIRE WEATHER WATCH IS POSTED FOR STRONG SOUTHWEST WINDS AND LOW FUEL MOISTURE BELOW 5,000 FEET IN EASTERN ARIZONA. Arizona will have increasing clouds with 20-35 MPH southwest winds this afternoon in the north and southeastern parts of the state. High temperatures will be in the mid 50's in the mountains and mid 80's in the southern deserts.

New Mexico and west Texas will be mostly sunny and breezy, except for partly cloudy skies in northwest New Mexico. High temperatures will be in the 80's to lower 90's and 60's to 70's in the mountains.

Western Montana will be partly cloudy with scattered afternoon thunderstorms mainly in the southwest. High temperatures will be in the $60^{\prime} \mathrm{s}$.

The Great Lakes States will experience a low pressure system moving in from the west today. Scattered showers and thunderstorms in Minnesota and Wisconsin will move into upper Michigan this afternoon. High temperatures
will be in the 60's in the north and 70 's in the south.
