## CURRENT SITUATION:

Initial attack fire activity remained minimal. Resource mobilization through the National Interagency Coordination Center consisted mainly of miscellaneous overhead and supplies. Very high and extreme fire indices were reported in Texas, New Mexico, Arizona and Michigan.

## SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

HOLIDAY, Apalachicola NF. A Type II Incident Management Team (Kearney) is assigned. This fire is burning on the Wakulla Ranger District, southwest of Tallahassee. Dry, hot weather and unpredictable fire behavior are causing control problems. Current threats are to timber and bee apiaries.


ALASKA LARGE FIRES:
CARLA LAKE, Fort Greely Army Base. This lightning caused fire is burning in grass and hardwoods 15 miles southwest of Delta Junction. Crews successfully completed a burn-out on the west side of the fire.

OUTLOOK:
