

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 12 1998 - 0530 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Moderate initial attack fire activity was reported in most Areas. The National Interagency Coordination Center processed orders for crews, helicopters, equipment and miscellaneous overhead. Radios, supplies and an Infrared Aircraft were mobilized to Canada. Very high and extreme fire indices were reported in Texas, Oklahoma, Arkansas, Minnesota, Michigan, South Dakota, New Mexico, Nevada, Utah, Idaho, Washington, Oregon and California.

NORTHWEST LARGE FIRES:

NORTH 25, Wenatchee NF. A Type II Incident Management Team (Furlong) is assigned. This fire is located 27 miles northwest of Chelan. Five Type I crews are staged at the incident.

ROWENA, Oregon State and Mt Hood NF. This fire, seven miles east of Hood River is being managed under Unified Command. The State of Oregon has initiated the Conflagration Act allowing for various counties to provide structural protection engines to aid in the suppression efforts.

CLAYTON COMPLEX, Umpqua NF. This complex is eight miles northeast of Tiller. A Type II Incident Management Team (Welch) is assigned. The complex consists of 13 fires with the largest fire at 206 acres. Fires on private land are being managed by Douglas County Forest Protection Association.

EASTERN GREAT BASIN LARGE FIRES:

GARN, Utah State. This fire is located 35 miles west of Logan. Burn out operations were planned last night to secure the north perimeter.

MAIN SALMON COMPLEX, Salmon-Challis NF. This complex is located 40 miles west northwest of Salmon. An Interagency Fire Use Management Team (O'Brien) is assigned. The complex consists of eight fires burning in the Frank Church River Of No Return Wilderness on the Salmon-Challis, Payette, Nez Perce and Bitterroot National Forests. A sprinkler system was established at Lantz Bar for structural protection. Contingency plans for protection of developments at five other sites are being completed. No threats currently

exist. Discussions have occurred with the State of Idaho, Department of Environmental Quality in preparation of an active smoke monitoring program.

JACKASS, Salmon-Challis NF. This fire is 30 miles southwest of Salmon. The fire is burning in large 1000 hour fuels and is backing into rocky country to the south. Approximately 30% of the total area has burned.
