

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 26, 1998 - 0530 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

In anticipation of Hurricane Bonnie, FEMA has tasked the Southern Area for two Type II Interagency Management Teams (Kearney and Bollman) to be staged at Fort Bragg, North Carolina to manage Receiving and Distribution centers. Minimal initial attack activity was reported. The National Interagency Coordination Center processed orders for helicopters, equipment and miscellaneous overhead. Very high to extreme indices were reported for Texas, Arizona, Utah, Nevada, California, Oregon, Washington, Idaho, Wyoming and South Dakota.

NORTHERN ROCKIES LARGE FIRES:

MILK RIVER, Blackfeet Agency, BIA. Good progress was made around the perimeter, yet hot spots remain inside the line. Two ranches to the east and one to the northwest are threatened.

PACK TRAIL, Bitterroot NF. This fire is located 10 miles east of Sula. A Type II Incident Management Team (Cowin) is assigned. The Team is re-evaluating the expected containment date. Helicopter bucket drops were used to control a flare-up on the southern flank in a steep and inaccessible area. Crews will not be working in this area because of the steep and unstable ground. Crews are making good progress on mop-up of the northern flank.

WEST FORK WILDERNESS FIRES, Bitterroot NF. An Interagency Fire Use Management Team (Wallace) is assigned. All fires exhibited increased activity.

MOOSE COMPLEX, Nez Perce NF. This complex of fires is located in the Selway-Bitterroot Wilderness. An Interagency Fire Use Management Team (Johnson) is assigned. A structure protection plan is being prepared for the Moose Creek Historic site, the Shissler Lookout, two foot bridges and a private ranch.

EASTERN GREAT BASIN LARGE FIRES:

NORTH FORK COMPLEX, Salmon-Challis NF. A Type I Incident Management Team

(Richer) is assigned. These fires are located approximately 20 miles northwest of Salmon. All lines and associated burnouts have been completed on the Upper and Lower Ebb fires. Excellent progress is being made toward containment of the other wilderness fires. Demobilization of excess resources has begun and is expected to increase rapidly the next several days.

LAID LOW, Salmon-Challis NF. A Type II Incident Management Team (Carr) is assigned. This fire is burning in an area of heavy bug kill 12 miles northwest of Stanley. Erratic winds caused the fire to expand in all directions with a major run to the north and northeast. Heavy smoke is making access and mapping the fire difficult.

MAIN SALMON COMPLEX, Salmon-Challis NF. An Interagency Fire Use Management Team (O'Brien) is assigned. This complex is 40 miles west northwest of Salmon. The complex consists of 14 fires, in the Frank Church River of No Return Wilderness on the Salmon-Challis, Payette, Nez Perce and Bitterroot National Forests. Active burning has stopped at elevations between 5600' and 6800' on all of the fires. Below freezing temperatures and frost were observed throughout the area on the evening of 8/24.

OUTLOOK:

A FIRE WEATHER WATCH IS POSTED IN WESTERN MONTANA FOR GUSTY, WESTERLY WINDS AND LOW HUMIDITY. Western Montana will have southwest to west winds of 15 to 30 MPH. Locally breezy conditions are forecast for California, Nevada, and Idaho. Arizona, New Mexico, eastern Nevada, Utah, Colorado and Wyoming will have scattered wet thunderstorms. Southeast Idaho and southern Montana will have scattered thunderstorms with a little rain. High temperatures will range from the 70's to 80's in the Northwest and Northern Rockies. The remainder of the West will have highs in the 90's to 110, with 70's and 80's in the mountains.
