

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 SATURDAY, OCTOBER 10, 1998 - 0900 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Minimal initial attack activity was reported. The National Interagency Coordination Center processed orders for miscellaneous equipment and overhead. Very high fire indices were reported in Oregon and California.

SOUTHERN AREA INCIDENTS:

HURRICANE GEORGES: Hutchinson's Type I Incident Management Team is managing the FEMA Receiving and Distribution Center at Roosevelt Roads Naval Base in Puerto Rico. The demobilization process has begun. FEMA is starting the recovery phase of the disaster assistance. The Team is finalizing their documentation package.

OUTLOOK:

A FIRE WEATHER WATCH IS POSTED IN NEW MEXICO ABOVE 8,000 FEET FOR BREEZY SOUTHWEST WINDS. Northern Idaho, northwestern Wyoming and Montana will have valley rain showers and snow showers over the mountains. Elsewhere it will be dry with 15-30 MPH gusty southwest to northwest winds, except lighter winds in the Pacific northwest. High temperatures will range from the 40's in the Northern Rockies to the 90's in the southwest deserts.

West Texas and the Oklahoma panhandle will be mostly sunny and breezy with 15-25 MPH south to southwest winds. High temperatures will be in the 80's and 90's.
