

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 14, 1998 - 0530 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Minimal initial attack fire activity was reported. High to very high fire indices were reported in southern California.

OUTLOOK:

A FIRE WEATHER WATCH IS POSTED IN NORTHERN ARIZONA FOR GUSTY SOUTHWEST WINDS, LOW HUMIDITY AND LOW FUEL MOISTURE. The West will have gusty southwest to northwest winds up to 35 MPH. An upper level trough will bring rain and mountain snow to Washington, Oregon, Idaho, western Montana, northern California and northwest Nevada. The remainder of the West will be dry. High temperatures will range from the 50's in the north to the lower 90's in the southwest deserts.

West Texas and the Oklahoma panhandle will be mostly sunny with gusty 10-20 MPH southwest winds. High temperatures will be in the mid 80's and 90's.
