

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT  
 SATURDAY, OCTOBER 24, 1998 - 0900 MDT  
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Minimal initial attack fire activity was reported nationally. Large fire activity was reported in the Northwest. The National Interagency Coordination Center processed orders for a caterer, helicopter, equipment and miscellaneous overhead. High to very high fire indices were reported in California, Mississippi, and Virginia.

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA LARGE FIRES:

PIRU, Ventura County, California. A Type II Incident Management Team (Festerling) is assigned. This fire is burning in heavy brush west of Castaic near Lake Piru. Line improvement and mop up continues.

OGILVY, Los Padres NF. A Type II Incident Management Team (McClain) is assigned. This fire is 13 miles northeast of Santa Barbara in the Dick Smith Wilderness. Indirect control lines have been established. Line improvement and mop up is continuing. Rehabilitation work has begun.

LOOKOUT II, Sequoia/Kings Canyon NP. A Type II Incident Management Team (Williams) is assigned. This fire is near Mineral King. Line holding on the ridge to the west and line construction east along the ridge is progressing well.

NORTH FORK, Malheur NF. This fire is located approximately thirty-five miles southeast of John Day. This human caused fire has been burning for some time in remote country bordering the Strawberry Wilderness. Fire behavior is creeping and smoldering. Bull trout habitat is threatened.
