

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 28, 1998 - 0530 MST
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

The Southern Area reported increased initial attack fire activity. The National Interagency Coordination Center processed orders for miscellaneous overhead. High fire dangers were reported in California, South Carolina, Tennessee, Virginia, Alabama, Mississippi and North Carolina.

NORTHWEST AREA LARGE FIRE:

NORTH FORK, Malheur NF. This fire is approximately 35 miles southeast of John Day. No new information was received. This will be the last report unless new information is received.

OUTLOOK:

A low pressure system will move out of Utah into Colorado and a Pacific cold front will bring an onshore flow with higher winds. California and Arizona will be mostly sunny and a little warmer. It will be partly cloudy over the southern California mountains and coast areas with a little increase in desert and ridge top winds. High temperatures will range from the 50's in the mountains, 70's along the southern California coast and low to mid 80's in the deserts.

Virginia will be partly sunny and dry with higher relative humidity and light winds. High temperatures will be in the 60's.
