

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 TUESDAY, DECEMBER 8, 1998 - 1000 MST
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION:

Initial attack fire activity continues to be above normal in the Southern Area as unseasonably warm and dry conditions prevail over much of the area. Units in Georgia and Alabama reported high fire indices.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

CHEAHA WILDERNESS, Alabama NF. A Type II Incident Management Team (Melton) is assigned. This arson fire is approximately 60 miles east of Birmingham. Access is difficult due to steep and rocky terrain. Acreage increase is partially due to a successful burnout operation.
