CURRENT SITUATION:

Rain in Florida helped moderate fire activity yesterday. Areas with lightning also received some precipitation. Some demobilization is occurring. No resource shortages currently exist.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

HICKORY ISLAND, Okefenokee NWR. This fire is burning near Folkston, GA. The fire received up to .24 inches of rain yesterday which will help firefighters complete control lines on the northwest side.
