

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 SATURDAY, MAY 1, 1999 - 1000 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

The Eastern Area experienced increased large fire activity. Warm and dry conditions are expected to continue into the weekend. Moderate fire activity continues in the Southern Area. The National Interagency Coordination Center processed orders for miscellaneous overhead. Very high and extreme fire indices were reported in Florida, Georgia, Louisiana, Minnesota and Wisconsin.

EASTERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

New Jersey State. This fire is burning one mile south of Warren Grove. The fire is burning in insect damaged forest lands. The fire began on a military reservation and burned onto state lands. Three state campgrounds have been evacuated.

St. Joe #1, Minnesota State Lands. This fire is burning in grass near Lancaster, MN. Kittson County Fire Department responded. No further information was reported.

OUTLOOK

*** A FIRE WEATHER WATCH IS POSTED FOR LOW HUMIDITIES IN NORTHWEST FLORIDA ***

Florida will be partly cloudy with scattered showers and thunderstorms. Minimum humidity will be 30-35 percent in the northwest. High temperatures will be in the 60's in the northeast to near 80 in the southern portion of the state.

Minnesota, Wisconsin and Michigan will be mostly sunny. Winds will be east to southeast 5-15 MPH. Minimum humidities will be 20-30 percent. The southern portions of the states will be windy with areas of showers and thunderstorms. High temperatures will be in the 70's.

New Jersey will be mostly sunny. Winds will be northeast 10-15 MPH. Minimum humidities will be 25-35 percent. High temperatures will be in the 60's.

New Mexico will be partly cloudy in the southwest with isolated mountain showers or thundertorms. Scattered showers and thunderstorms will occur in the north and east with locally heavy rain. High temperatures will be in the high 50's to low 60's in the north, and 70's in the south.
