

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT  
 SATURDAY, MAY 22, 1999 - 0900 MDT  
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Moderate initial attack activity was reported in Southern Area, with minimal initial attack fire activity being reported elsewhere. Mobilization of resources through the National Interagency Coordination Center included a type 1 helicopter and miscellaneous overhead. Very high and extreme fire indices were reported in Georgia, Arizona Texas and New Mexico.

ALASKA AREA LARGE FIRES:

EKLUTNA, State of Alaska, Mat-Su Area Forestry. A Type II Incident Management Team (McKnight) is assigned. This fire is located approximately 20 miles northeast of Anchorage. Dozers and crews continued to build and improve the line. High humidities helped firefighters hold the fire line during brisk afternoon winds. Significant progress was made on the north side to reduce the threat to homes in the area.

OUTLOOK:

Alaska will be partly cloudy with a chance of afternoon showers at higher elevations and isolated thunderstorms over the Alaska Range. High temperatures will range from 35 to 45 degrees in the north slope region, and 45 to 65 degrees elsewhere, with warmest conditions along the southern

interior.

Florida will be partly cloudy with a chance of afternoon thunderstorms in the south, and a slight chance of thunderstorms in the central and northern sections. Minimum humidities will range from 39 to 45 percent.

The New Mexico mountains and southern panhandle of west Texas will be partly cloudy with a chance of afternoon thunderstorms. Arizona will be partly cloudy. Locally windy conditions are forecast in the afternoon over the entire area. Minimum humidities will range from 10 to 15 percent. High temperatures will be in the upper 60's and 70's over the Arizona mountains, near 105 along the Rio Grande of west Texas, and mid 80's to upper 90's elsewhere.

Southern California will be partly cloudy, with areas of coastal low clouds and fog in the morning. A slight chance of afternoon showers is forecast over the San Bernardino mountains. Highs will range from the upper 60's to low 70's along the coast and mountains, upper 70's to mid 80's in the deserts, and lower 90's in the Coachella Valley.
