

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 SUNDAY, JUNE 13, 1999 - 0900 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Large fire activity continued in the Alaska and Southwest Areas. New large fire activity was reported in Western Great Basin, while initial attack activity was minimal elsewhere. Mobilization of resources through the National Interagency Coordination Center included Infrared Aircraft, smokejumpers and miscellaneous overhead. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in California, New Mexico, Arizona, West Texas, Colorado and Nevada.

SOUTHWEST AREA LARGE FIRES:

RAINBOW, Fort Apache Agency. A Type I Incident Management Team (Humphrey) is assigned. This fire is near White River, AZ. Approximately twenty homes and some outbuildings have been lost. The Indian Health Service and three subdivisions are threatened. The use of engines and handcrews have slowed the fire spread. Extremely dry fuels and low relative humidity are contributing to extreme fire behavior.

GARDNER, Coronado National Forest. The fire is not expected to present any problems. Containment was expected last night.

MT.EMMA, Grand Canyon NP. A Fire Use Management Team (Zimmerman) is assigned. This lightning ignited wildland fire is being managed to accomplish resource objectives. The fire is burning 5 miles southwest of Tuweep Ranger Station on the Grand Canyon's North Rim. Minimal line was constructed; helicopter bucket drops were made to limit fire spread along the western flank into identified sensitive resource areas in the Mt. Logan Wilderness Area. Lower acreage reflects more accurate GPS mapping.

ALASKA LARGE FIRE:

DONNELLY, Fort Greely Army Base. A Type II Incident Management Team (Jandt) is assigned. This fire is twenty-five miles south of Delta, AK.

Erratic winds and spotting contributed towards rapid spread and hampered suppression efforts.

Current threats are to pipeline pump station nine and homesteads along the Richardson Highway.

WESTERN GREAT BASIN LARGE FIRES:

FAIRVIEW, Winnemucca Field Office. This fire is thirty-five miles northwest of Lovelock, NV. The fire is burning in steep inaccessible terrain. Wild horse habitat is threatened.

MILL, Winnemucca Field Office. This fire is thirty-five miles west of Winnemucca, near Imlay, NV. One structure was threatened; quick response prevented any damage.

OUTLOOK:

A FIRE WEATHER WATCH IS POSTED IN ALASKA FOR THE MATANUSKA, SUSTINA VALLEYS AND COPPER RIVER ZONES FOR AFTERNOON THUNDERSTORMS AND DRY, WINDY CONDITIONS.

A FIRE WEATHER WATCH IS ALSO POSTED IN ALASKA FOR THE DELTA AND HEALY AREAS THIS AFTERNOON FOR GUSTY WINDS AND LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITY.

Alaska southeast panhandle will be cloudy with a chance of rain. High temperatures will be in the 60s. Southern Alaska will be mostly cloudy with scattered showers on the coast, with high temperatures in the 60s. The interior will be partly cloudy with scattered afternoon showers and thunderstorms. High temperatures will be mid 60's to low 80's. Northern Alaska will be mostly sunny with scattered afternoon thunderstorms. High temperatures will be in the mid 80s to low 90s, except along the western coast which will be in the 50s

New Mexico will be partly cloudy with scattered afternoon thunderstorms in the central mountains and west. High temperatures will be in the 60's to 70's in the mountains and the east, and 80's to lower 90 elsewhere.

Arizona will be mostly sunny with a slight chance of afternoon thunderstorms in the northeast. High temperatures will be in the 70's in the mountains to 107 in the lowest deserts.

Northern Florida and Georgia will be partly cloudy with scattered afternoon showers and thunderstorms. High temperatures will be in the 80's in Georgia to lower 90's northern Florida.
