INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT FRIDAY, JUNE 9, 2000 - 0530 MDT NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL III

#### CURRENT SITUATION:

New large fires were reported in the Southern Area and the Northern Rockies. Initial attack activity was light to moderate in the Southwest, Great Basin, Rocky Mountain, and Southern Areas. Several large fires in Florida and Arizona were contained. The National Interagency Coordination Center mobilized helicopters, an air attack aircraft, infrared aircraft, radio equipment, engines, crews, and miscellaneous overhead. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in New Mexico, Arizona, Nevada, Utah, Colorado, Wyoming, Idaho, California, Texas, Oklahoma, Mississippi, Kansas, and Minnesota.

### SOUTHWEST AREA LARGE FIRES:

RATTLESNAKE, Coronado National Forest. A Type II Incident Management Team (Leech) is assigned. The fire is in the foothills north of Tucson, AZ. Lower temperatures and higher humidity yesterday aided crews in making significant progress along the flanks of the fire. Extremely steep and rugged terrain is challenging containment efforts.

CERRO GRANDE, Bandelier National Park. An Area Command Team (Mann) and two Type II Incident Management Teams (Carr and Smith) are assigned. The fire is near Los Alamos, NM. Rehabilitation work continues with a target date for completion of July, 1. Rehabilitation efforts are being completed to mitigate possible flooding and mudslides expected during the monsoon season.

VIVEASH, Santa Fe National Forest. A Type II Incident Management Team (Bedlion) is assigned. This fire is burning in ponderosa pine and mixed conifer five miles northwest of Pecos, NM. Fire activity has been minimal in the past 24 hours. Crews continue to mop up and extinguish hot spots. A Burned Area Emergency Rehabilitation (BAER) Team is coordinating reseeding efforts on two divisions.

PUMPKIN, Kaibab National Forest. A Type II Incident Management Team (Johnson) is assigned. The fire is 15 miles northwest of Flagstaff, AZ. The fire received winds up to 43 mph, but all firelines held. Crews are continuing mop up and holding actions to prevent the fire from spreading southwest of Kendrick Mountain toward Newman Hill.

OUTLET, Grand Canyon National Park. A Type II Incident Management Team (McElwain) is assigned. The fire is 25 miles south of Jacob Lake, AZ. Despite gusty winds yesterday fire activity was moderate and the containment lines held. Crews continue to build fireline in the canyon near Kibbey Butte to halt the fire's spread to the south. Mop up is occurring on the north and west sides of the fire.

CHANCE, Socorro District BLM. A Type II Incident Management Team (Bustamante) is assigned. This lightning caused fire is burning in grass and light fuels 30 miles south of Datil, NM. Higher humidity and light

rain in the area aided suppression efforts yesterday. A ranch, a historic homestead and archeological sites are threatened.

MAGDALENA COMPLEX, Cibola National Forest. This is a complex of 17 fires west of Socorro, NM. The largest is the Backbone fire on New Mexico State Forestry lands, which is now contained at 950 acres. Fuels include grass, pinyon-juniper and ponderosa pine.

#### SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

A Type II Incident Management Team (Kearney) is staged in Gainesville, FL.

10TH STREET, Florida State Division of Forestry. The fire is in Bithlo, 10 miles east of Orlando, FL. Strong down drafts and wind shifts pushed the fire toward residences. One county brush truck was burned over, but the crew was not injured.

LOUISE #3, Florida State Division of Forestry. The fire is located near Gainesville, FL. High winds and spotting are challenging containment efforts. Highway 225 could be impacted by the fire's spread.

LOUISE #4, Florida State Division of Forestry. This fire is burning in heavy fuels near Gainesville, FL. High winds and spotting are hampering control efforts. The cause of the fire is unknown.

CYPRESS #2, Florida State Division of Forestry. The fire is near Golden Gate, ten miles east of Naples, FL. Smoke from this fire reduced visibility on Highway 75. Some voluntary evacuations of residences have occurred. Spotting and heavy fuel loading are causing containment problems.

DC COMMAND, Florida State Division of Forestry. The fire is located near Homestead, FL. No structures are threatened. The fire received heavy rain and containment was expected last night.

JACKSON HOLE, Florida State Division of Forestry. The fire is burning in hardwood fuels near Cross City, FL. Dozers were expected to complete fireline construction last night.

COUNTY LINE, Florida State Division of Forestry. This fire is near Okeechobee, FL. Drought conditions and inaccessibility are causing problems. Containment was expected last night.

BUNDY LAKE, Florida State Division of Forestry. The fire is burning in heavy fuels 15 miles northeast of Gainesville, FL. The acreage change is due to more accurate mapping.

BRIGHT HOUR, Florida State Division of Forestry. This fire is in Desoto County. Rough and remote terrain are causing containment problems.

DANVILLE, Florida State Division of Forestry. The fire is located in Union County. No new information was reported.

MICROWAVE, Florida State Division of Forestry. This fire is located in Osceola County, FL. No new information was reported.

UPPER SLIDE, Bridger-Teton National Forest. A Type II Incident Management Team (Saleen) is assigned. The fire is burning in subalpine fir, lodgepole pine and spruce 20 miles northeast of Jackson, WY. Dry fuels combined with high temperatures, low relative humidities and windy conditions are hampering containment efforts. The fire continues to spread toward the Gros Ventre Wilderness.

### FOR LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITIES \*\*\*

Arizona, New Mexico, southern Utah, southern Colorado, and southern Nevada will become cooler and more humid as a trough moves into the Great Basin. Scattered thunderstorms in Utah and New Mexico will be wetter, but dry thunderstorms are still possible in Colorado ahead of the trough. Temperatures will range from the upper 60's in the northern mountains to near 105 in the deserts. Windy conditions will continue with southwest winds at 15 to 30 mph. Minimum relative humidities will be near 10 percent in the driest areas.

Florida will be partly cloudy with scattered showers and thunderstorms. High temperatures will be in the mid 80's to the lower 90's. Winds will be east at 10 to 15 mph. Minimum relative humidities will be 30 to 35 percent in the panhandle and the northeast part of the state, and up to 50 percent in south Florida.

A fire weather watch is posted for southern and eastern Wyoming for dry lightning and gusty winds.
