

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT  
 THURSDAY, OCTOBER 19, 2000 - 0530 MDT  
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION:

Initial attack activity was light throughout the nation. No new large fires were reported to the National Interagency Coordination Center.

OUTLOOK:

\*\*\* FIRE WEATHER WATCH IN ALL OF MISSISSIPPI FOR LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITY AND LOW FUEL MOISTURES.\*\*\*

A weak low pressure system will drift across southern California bringing high clouds and cooler temperatures to the area. High temperatures will range from the 70's and 80's in the mountains and along the coast to the upper 90's in the southern deserts. Minimum afternoon relative humidity will be 10 to 20 percent in the deserts, 15 to 35 percent inland, and higher along the coast. Winds will be northeast to southeast at 10 to 20 mph over the mountains and deserts with onshore winds at 10 to 15 along the coast.

A weak upper level disturbance will move over Florida today bringing isolated showers across the northern part of the state. High temperatures will be in the 80's. Minimum relative humidity will be 30 to 45 percent in the northern part of the state and 35 to 50 percent in the southern areas. Winds will be north 5 to 15 mph.
