INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT FRIDAY, MARCH 9, 2001 - 1000 MST NATIONAL PREPARDNESS LEVEL 1

CURRENT SITUATION:

The Southern Area reported five new large fires to the National Interagency Coordination Center this past week and five of their large fires reached containment status. Moderate initial attack activity continues in Florida, Georgia and South Carolina. A low in the Gulf of Mexico will bring scattered showers to the Southeast today with fair weather over the weekend.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

SOPCHOPPY, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is near Sopchoppy, FL and jumped Highway 319 in several spots.

DALLUS CREEK, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is near Perry, FL and has spotted into several hardwood sloughs.

RED BEACH, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is in Highlands County, FL. No new information received.

TALL PINE, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is in Polk County, FL. No new information received.

MULTI COMMAND, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is in Dade County, FL.

SUMMERSET COMMAND, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is in Martin County, FL. No new information received.

OUTLOOK:

A cold front will move through the Southeast Friday with scattered showers. Conditions will be fair Saturday and Sunday. Another cold front will move through the region Monday and Tuesday with a chance of showers and wind with decreasing clouds Wednesday and Thursday. High temperatures will mostly be in the 60's except for Florida with high temperatures in the 70's and 80's.

South Texas will have high pressure building over the area Friday with partly cloudy skies and winds at 15 to 25 mph. A frontal system will move through the area late Saturday bringing a chance of showers till Monday. High temperatures will be mostly in the 70's to mid 80's.

In the West, low pressure centered near Lake Tahoe will produce a chance of showers from parts of Oregon down into Northern California. Skies will be partly to mostly cloudy across the rest of the region. High temperatures will be in the 40's to mid 50's across most of the West, with high temperatures in the 50's to mid 60's from Eastern Wyoming south into California, New Mexico and Arizona.

A high pressure system over St. Louis will create sunny to partly cloudy skies over the Northern Plains states. Southward into Texas there will be cloud cover but conditions will be dry. Michigan and much of Ohio will remain under the influence of low pressure with a chance of early morning snow flurries, then will begin to clear. High temperatures will be in the 30's from North Dakota into Indiana and Ohio, 40's for central South Dakota all the way to Missouri, 50's for central Nebraska to east Oklahoma and 60's over western Kansas and Oklahoma.

Snow can be expected over most of the Northeast as a low pressure system moves into the Atlantic just off Long Island. Northern Maine, Maryland and the Virginias will have mostly cloudy skies. High temperatures will be in the low 30's to low 40's in areas of snowfall while Washington D.C. south will have high temperatures in the mid 40's to the mid 50's.
