

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 WEDNESDAY, MAY 9, 2001 - 0530 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 1

CURRENT SITUATION:

One new large fire was reported in Florida and one large fire was contained in Pennsylvania. Initial attack activity was moderate in the Southern Area and light elsewhere. Florida and the Atlantic coast will remain dry as high pressure aloft persists, continuing the possibility of new large fire activity. High pressure will build in the Southwest, resulting in warm temperatures and moderate winds with a few showers and thunderstorms. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Colorado and Florida.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

BURNS, Big Cypress National Park. This human-caused fire is in southern Florida near Everglades National Park. Crews and helicopters are working the south and east flanks, while a burnout operation is taking place on the north side of the fire. Unburned islands are creating smoky conditions.

LONGINO RANCH COMMAND, Florida Division of Forestry. The fire is eight miles east of North Port, FL. The current threat is to Interstate 75 and timber resources. Low humidity and high winds are hindering containment efforts.

NO BUSINESS, Cherokee National Forest. This fire is four miles southwest of Erwin, TN. No new information was received.

NORTHERN ROCKIES LARGE FIRES:

CORRAL CREEK 2, Crow Agency, Bureau of Indian Affairs. This fire is burning four miles east of Lodge Grass, MT. Air resources supported suppression personnel and strong winds are hindering containment efforts.

SVENSON, Southern Land Office, Montana Department of Natural Resources and Conservation. The fire is north of Reed Point, MT. No new information was received.

OUTLOOK:

*** A FIRE WEATHER WATCH IS POSTED IN MOST OF FLORIDA FOR LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITY AND STRONG WINDS ***

High pressure aloft will continue to keep Florida and the Atlantic coast dry as a trough pushes across the mid-Atlantic states. A few lingering showers and thunderstorms are possible across the area. High temperatures will be in the 70's and 80's. Minimum relative humidity will be 35 to 45 percent from North Carolina to Florida, with humidity from 50 to 70 percent at locations to the west. Winds will be east to northeast at 10 to 20 mph in Florida and less than 10 mph elsewhere.

High pressure aloft will build over the Southwest with only lingering moisture across the region. This may help produce a few showers and thunderstorms over the higher terrain. Skies will generally be partly cloudy across the area. High temperatures will range from the 70's in the mountains to 110 in the hottest deserts. Minimum relative humidity will be five to 15 percent in the hottest deserts and 20 to 30 percent in the mountains. Winds will be from the west to southwest at 10 to 20 mph.
