

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 THURSDAY, JUNE 7, 2001 - 0530 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 2

CURRENT SITUATION:

Three new large fires were reported in Florida. Five large fires in Florida and New Mexico reached containment. Initial activity was moderate in Florida and light elsewhere. Fire indices were very high to extreme in Arizona, southern California, Colorado, Nevada, New Mexico, Texas, and Utah.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

CRAVEN ISLAND, Okefenokee National Wildlife Refuge. A Fire Use Management Team (Cook) is assigned. This fire is near Minnies Island, GA. Fire remains active with no significant acreage gained. REFLECTION, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is 13 miles east, southeast of the Orlando airport. The fire had a small increase in acreage during the night.

FOUR MILE RUN, Florida Division of Forestry. This fire is in monitor status.

DIXIE/LAFAYETTE COMPLEX, Florida Division of Forestry. A State Type 2 Incident Management Team (Koehler) is assigned. This fire is 25 miles north of Perry, FL. No new information was reported. This will be the last report unless new information is received.

SQUAWK CREEK 2, Everglades National Park. This fire is four miles west of the Pa-Hey-Okee overlook in the Squawk Creek area. No new information was reported. This will be the last report unless new information is received.

BIG, Shasta-Trinity National Forest. A Type 2 Incident Management Team (Szczepanik) is assigned. This fire is 14 miles west of Weaverville, CA. No new information was reported.

OUTLOOK:

Moist tropical air continues to flow into Florida producing partly cloudy skies and scattered thundershowers. High temperatures will be in the mid 80's to mid 90's. Minimum relative humidity will be above 45 percent and winds will be south to west at 5 to 15 mph.

High pressure building over the southwest, southern Nevada, and western Texas brings mostly sunny skies except for a few thunderstorms over northern and eastern New Mexico and west Texas. High temperatures will be from the mid 70's to mid 80's in the mountains and 105 to 110 degrees in the deserts. Minimum relative humidity will range from 5 to 15 percent. Winds will be variable at 10 to 20 mph.

A high pressure system continues to build over most of the Great Basin and western Colorado bringing partly cloudy skies and a warming trend. A few dry thunderstorms are expected in Utah and southwestern Colorado. High temperatures will be in the mid 60's to mid 70's in the mountains, mid 80's to mid 90's in the valleys, and near 105 in the deserts. Minimum relative humidity will range from 5 to 15 percent, and winds will generally be from the west at 10 to 20 mph.
