

**INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT  
FRIDAY, DECEMBER 13, 2002 – 1000 MST  
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 1**

**CURRENT SITUATION:**

Initial attack activity was light across the nation for the week. Nationally, 78 new fires were reported for the week ending December 13<sup>th</sup>. Two new large fires were reported during the week, one in the Southwest Area and one in the Eastern Area. One large fire was contained in the Eastern Area. Very high fire indices were reported in California.

**SOUTHWEST AREA LARGE FIRES:**

IDA II, Coronado National Forest. Burning in mixed conifer with Oak brush, this fire is 1 mile east of Methodist Camp, AZ. This is a low intensity burning fire in monitor status, growth potential is low.

**SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA AREA:**

SUPER TYPHOON PONGSONA SUPPORT, Federal Emergency Management Agency, Guam. Support to the incident is being provided by miscellaneous overhead and equipment. Concerns include fuel tank fires, power and water outages and caring for injured. Power and water outages are hampering shelter and feeding programs. This will be the last report unless significant activity occurs.

## OUTLOOK:

Wisconsin will be between two areas of surface low pressure over the next 24 hours; one moving northeast up the Ohio Valley and one moving across central Canada. An upper level trough will swing through the Great Lakes on Friday keeping skies mostly cloudy. Minimum temperatures will be in the mid 20s to low 30s with highs in the mid 30s to low 40s. Expect variable winds at 3 to 7 mph.
