INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT SUNDAY MAY 11, 2003 - 0800 MDT NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 2

CURRENT SITUATION:

Initial attack activity was light nationally, with 21 new fires reported yesterday. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Arizona, Minnesota, and New Mexico.

COLUMBIA RESPONSE, Federal Emergency Management Agency. A Type 2 Incident Management Team (Suwyn) is assigned to search operations near Modena, Utah. Crews have searched approximately 85 percent of the 1,161 acre area.

SOUTHWEST AREA LARGE FIRES:

WALKER, Lincoln National Forest. A Type 2 Team (Raley) is assigned. This fire 15 miles east of Cloudcroft, NM is burning in juniper, ponderosa and pinyon pine. Isolated torching and creeping was observed yesterday. Steep terrain and some spotting have hampered containment efforts.

BOILER, Gila National Forest. This lightning caused Wildland Fire Use fire is ten miles northwest of Poverty Creek, NM and is being managed to accomplish resource objectives. No new information was reported.

OUTLOOK:

Weather Discussion: High pressure ridge building over the West will produce a warming trend and decreasing winds in the Southwest. In the East, showers will extend from a low pressure system in the Great Lakes across the Ohio River Valley then southward along the cold front into Texas. Ahead of the cold front, warm dry weather along with some gusty winds is expected in Florida, Georgia and the Carolinas. In Alaska, winds over the Alaska Range will decrease as a low pressure system spreads showers over the interior and southern sections.
