Initial attack activity was light nationally, with new 103 fires reported yesterday. One large fire was contained in the Southwest Area. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Arizona, Colorado, Kansas, Minnesota, New Mexico, Oklahoma, and Texas.

SOUTHWEST AREA LARGE FIRES:

BOILER, Gila National Forest. This lightning caused Wildland Fire Use fire is ten miles northwest of Poverty Creek, NM and is being managed to accomplish resource objectives. Active fire behavior was observed in the north and west portions of the fire.
